

## Frequently Asked Questions RE: Caseload Limitations for SLP/SLP-As in the Public School System

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## Q: What is the maximum caseload limitation?

A: Per KRS 334A.190 65 pupils for an SLP NOT supervising an SLP-A and 65 plus up to ½ for an SLP who is supervising an SLP-A.

Q: If an SLP-A is supervised by two SLPs can each of those SLPs increase their caseload by up to ½?

A: No.

Q: Whose responsibility is it to make sure the SLP is adhering to proper caseload?

A: It is ultimately the SLPs responsibility to understand and follow the laws and regulations set forth by the licensing Board.

Q: What is the caseload limitation for an SLP who is covering while another SLP is out of the office (maternity leave, FMLA, etc.)?

A: There are no statutes or regulations that allow for additional caseload limits based on these situations. The limit would remain 65.

Q: Can an SLP or school system ask for a waiver to go over the 65-caseload cap?

A: There is no waiver available.
