AGREED ORDER

Parties

WHEREAS, the parties to the Agreed Order herein are the Kentucky Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, hereinafter referred to as the "Board," and Alecia Manning, hereinafter referred to as the "Respondent."

Jurisdiction

WHEREAS, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to KRS Chapter 334A and the related administrative regulations.

History

WHEREAS, on or about July 3, 2013, the Board filed an administrative complaint against the Respondent alleging that the Respondent had practiced after her license had lapsed;

WHEREAS, the Board acknowledges that a complaint was not filed against Dr. Manning by a consumer but that this violation arose merely out of the lapse of her licensure;

WHEREAS, the parties mutually desire to settle the issues in an expeditious manner, without the need for a formal hearing.

Terms of Agreement

THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed between the undersigned parties that this matter shall be settled and resolved upon the following terms:

- 1) The Respondent shall carefully review the Agreed Order herein and enters into

this Agreed Order knowingly, willingly and voluntarily and after having reviewed the due process rights afforded to her under KRS Chapter 334A and the accompanying regulations;

2) The Respondent, Alecia Manning, acknowledges that the Board has accused her of violation of KRS 334A.030(2) and KRS 334A.180(1)(c and f) in count I of the complaint.

The Respondent admits violation of those provisions;

3) *The Respondent shall pay a fine of \$100.* Payment of the fine shall be made by sending a personal check or money order made payable to the Kentucky Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, to the Board Office such that it is received prior to November 1, 2013;

4) Respondent acknowledges that non-payment or a check returned for insufficient funds shall constitute noncompliance with this agreement. In the event that a check is returned for insufficient funds, the Board may proceed with an administrative hearing on this matter pursuant to the procedures and processes outlined in KRS 334A and KRS 13B;

5) The Respondent agrees that she shall notify all third party payors who she billed for services between March 2, 2013 (when the grace period ended) and March 20, 2013 (when she received her temporary license in advance of her full license) with a copy of those notices being to be received by the Board on or before November 1, 2013;

6) The Respondent agrees that, by entering into this Agreed Order, she has waived her right to appeal this administrative matter;

7) If the Respondent fails to comply with the terms of this Agreed Order in any way, the Board may reinstate the action against the Respondent and/or take any additional action authorized pursuant to KRS 334A and KRS 13B.

8) This agreement shall constitute the final resolution of the violations allegedly committed by the Respondent and referenced in the "History" subsection of this agreement.

Voluntary Waiver of Rights

The Respondent, Alecia Manning, has had the opportunity at all times to seek advice from competent counsel of choice. No coercion has been exerted upon the Respondent, nor have any promises been made other than those reflected in this Agreed Order.


Publication of Settlement Agreement

The Respondent acknowledges that, once adopted by the Board, this Agreed Order may be considered a public document, available for inspection at any time by any member of the public under the Kentucky Open Records Act, and may be reportable under federal law. Further, the Board may publish this Agreed Order or the substance of this agreement in a manner consistent with the public purpose of the Board.

Complete Agreement

This Agreed Order consists of five pages, inclusive of the Certificate of Service, and embodies the entire agreement between Kentucky Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology and the Respondent, Alecia Manning. It may not be altered, amended or modified without the express written consent of both parties.
