***AGREED ORDER***

***Parties***

**WHEREAS**, the parties to the Agreed Order herein are the Kentucky Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, hereinafter referred to as the "Board," and Vrushali Angadi, hereinafter referred to as the "Respondent."

***Jurisdiction***

**WHEREAS**, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to KRS Chapter 334A and the related administrative regulations.

***History***

**WHEREAS**, on or about July 3, 2013, the Board filed an administrative complaint against the Respondent alleging that the Respondent had practiced after her interim license had lapsed;

**WHEREAS**, the Board acknowledges that a mitigating factor exists. Specifically, the Board's licensure verification database was partially inaccurate insofar as it listed the Respondent's license status as "active" but concurrently indicated that the license had an expiration date which had passed;

WHEREAS, the parties mutually desire to settle the issues in an expeditious manner, without the need for a formal hearing.

*Terms of Agreement*

THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed between the undersigned parties that this matter shall be settled and resolved upon the following terms:

1) The Respondent shall carefully review the Agreed Order herein and enters into this Agreed Order knowingly, willingly and voluntarily and after having reviewed the due process rights afforded to her under KRS Chapter 334A and the accompanying regulations;

2) The Respondent, Vrushali Angadi, acknowledges that the Board has accused her of violation of KRS 334A.030(2) and KRS 334A.180(1)(c and f) in count 1 of the complaint. Further, the Board has accused her of violation of KRS 334A.180(1)(c). *The Respondent admits violation of the provisions listed in count 1.* In the interest of settling this case in an expeditious manner, the Board agrees to dismiss the charge listed in count 2 of the complaint;

3) *The Respondent shall pay a fine of \$300.* Payment of the fine shall be made by sending a personal check or money order made payable to the Kentucky Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, to the Board Office such that it is received prior to September 1, 2013;

4) Respondent acknowledges that non-payment or a check returned for insufficient funds shall constitute noncompliance with this agreement. In the event that a check is returned for insufficient funds, the Board may proceed with an administrative hearing on this matter pursuant to the procedures and processes outlined in KRS 334A and KRS 13B;

5) The Respondent agrees that she shall cause the University of Kentucky to be notified of the lapse in her licensure with documentation evidencing that such notification has occurred delivered to the Board such that it is received on or before September 1, 2013;

6) The Respondent agrees that, by entering into this Agreed Order, she has waived her right to appeal this administrative matter;

7) If the Respondent fails to comply with the terms of this Agreed Order in any way, the Board may reinstate the action against the Respondent and/or take any additional action authorized pursuant to KRS 334A and KRS 13B.

8) This agreement shall constitute the final resolution of the violations allegedly committed by the Respondent and referenced in the "History" subsection of this agreement.

***Voluntary Waiver of Rights***

The Respondent, Vrushali Angadi, has had the opportunity at all times to seek advice from competent counsel of choice. No coercion has been exerted upon the Respondent, nor have any promises been made other than those reflected in this Agreed Order.


***Publication of Settlement Agreement***



***Complete Agreement***


