## **Board Attorney's Report**

Board Counsel, Sara Janes, presented an updated draft of the amendments to 201 KAR 17:090 for Board review and approval. Counsel updated the prior draft for format pursuant to KRS 13A in order to file the amendment to the ordinary administrative regulation with LRC. Counsel also included a new Section 4. Incorporation by Reference. to include the "Application for Continuing Education Program Approval" form and Board address and website as is required to be included by law. Finally, the draft included the Regulatory Impact Analysis and Tiering Statement which the Board assisted with language in the need for the amendments, a Fiscal Impact Statement and Summary of Materials Incorporated by Reference, which are also required by KRS Chapter 13A. Finally, Board Counsel presented a reformatted Application for Continuing Education Program Approval" for Board review and approval.

A motion was made by Tamara Cranfill to have Chairman Lutes assist Board counsel with finalizing the amendment for filing and to approve the 201 KAR 17:090 and CEU form updates. Angela Mikel seconded the motion and the motion carried.

The Board discussed 201 KAR 17:036.

Board Counsel requested that the Board ASLP-IC delegates update Board counsel immediately when a rule is adopted by the Interstate Compact Commission ("Commission") because KRS 334A.Section 15.B.1 requires the Board to file an emergency and ordinary administrative regulation within sixty (60) days of the adoption of a rule by the Commission.

The Board & Commissions Support Specialist presented a news and resource report from ASHA for Board review.

The Board discussed the 2024 NCSB conference. Tamara Cranfill volunteered to attend the conference on behalf of the Board. Chairman Lutes motioned for Tamara Cranfill to attend the 2024 NCSB conference. Angela Mikel seconded the motion and the motion carried.

The Board discussed an email inquiry regarding whether the Board allows CEU hours to be given to a licensee who watches a recording of an approved CEU course instead of attending it live.
