



## **Frequently Asked Questions RE: Caseload Limitations for SLP/SLP-As in the Public School System**

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### **Q: What is the maximum caseload limitation?**

A: Per [KRS 334A.190](#) 65 pupils for an SLP NOT supervising an SLP-A and 65 plus up to ½ for an SLP who is supervising an SLP-A.

### **Q: If an SLP-A is supervised by two SLPs can each of those SLPs increase their caseload by up to ½?**

A: No.

### **Q: Whose responsibility is it to make sure the SLP is adhering to proper caseload?**

A: It is ultimately the SLPs responsibility to understand and follow the laws and regulations set forth by the licensing Board.

### **Q: What is the caseload limitation for an SLP who is covering while another SLP is out of the office (maternity leave, FMLA, etc.)?**

A: There are no statutes or regulations that allow for additional caseload limits based on these situations. The limit would remain 65.

### **Q: Can an SLP or school system ask for a waiver to go over the 65-caseload cap?**

A: There is no waiver available.
