

AGREED ORDER

Parties

WHEREAS, the parties to the Agreed Order herein are the Kentucky Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, hereinafter referred to as the "Board," and Jennifer Head hereinafter referred to as the "Respondent."

Jurisdiction

WHEREAS, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to KRS Chapter 334A and the related administrative regulations.

History

WHEREAS, the Respondent made renewal application for an speechlanguage pathology license in January 2009;

WHEREAS, during the application process, the Respondent self-reported that she entered a diversion program related to felony criminal charges;

WHEREAS, the parties mutually desire to settle the issues in an expeditious manner, without the need for a formal hearing.

Terms of Agreement

THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed between the undersigned parties that this matter shall be settled and resolved upon the following terms:

- 1) The Respondent shall carefully review the Agreed Order herein and enters into this Agreed Order knowingly, willingly and voluntarily and after having reviewed the due process rights afforded to him under KRS Chapter 334A and the accompanying regulations;
- The Respondent, Jennifer Head, acknowledges that the Board has accused her of violations of KRS 334A.180, 201 KAR 17:041(3)(1)(b), and 201 KAR 17:041(3). The Respondent admits violation of those provisions. In the interest of settling this case in an expeditious manner, the Respondent agrees to the following terms set forth in the subsequent paragraphs;
- 3) The Respondent, Jennifer Head, shall pay to the Board a fine in the sum of \$500. Payment of the fine shall be made by sending a personal check or money order made payable to the Kentucky Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, along with this signed Agreed Order, to the Board Office such that they are received prior to April 3, 2009. The Respondent has the option of either (1) paying the entire \$500 at that time or (2) paying \$250 at that time and paying \$250 prior to May 3, 2009;
- 4) Respondent acknowledges that a check returned for insufficient funds shall constitute noncompliance with this agreement. In the event that a check is returned for insufficient funds, the Board may proceed with an administrative hearing on this matter pursuant to the procedures and processes outlined in KRS 13B;
- 5) Respondent shall complete 5.0 hours of continuing education focused on ethics. The Respondent shall submit proof to the Board that this continuing education has been completed prior to her next

renewal date. This term is in addition to any continuing education that Respondent is required to complete to retain her license;

- 6) The Respondent agrees that she will continue to meet her obligations under the Daviess County Drug Court Program as ordered in Case No. 08-CR-00283, Daviess Circuit Court. The Respondent has an affirmative obligation to update the Board in the event that she is terminated from the Drug Court program. In the event that the Respondent is terminated from the Drug Court program, she shall cease practicing until such time as the Board may determine her licensing status;
- 7) This agreement shall constitute the final resolution of the violations allegedly committed by the Respondent and referenced in the "History" subsection of this agreement.

Voluntary Waiver of Rights

The Respondent, Jennifer Head, has had the opportunity at all times to seek advice from competent counsel of choice. No coercion has been exerted upon the Respondent, nor have any promises been made other than those reflected in this Agreed Order.

Publication of Settlement Agreement

The Respondent acknowledges that, once adopted by the Board, this Agreed Order may be considered a public document, available for inspection at any time by any member of the public under the Kentucky Open Records Act, and may be reportable under federal law.

Complete Agreement

This Settlement Agreement consists of four pages and embodies the entire agreement between Kentucky Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology and the Respondent, Jennifer Head. It may not be altered, amended or modified without the express written consent of both parties.
