Chairman Keefe suggested the Board move forward with a vote with the update to 201 KAR: 110 that removes the requirement that a practitioner-patient relationship must begin in person before moving to telehealth. Ms. Roof made a motion to move forward with these changes. Chairman Keefe seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. Mr. Ruschell advised he would not be able to file this before the December 15 deadline but would do so by January 15.

Mr. Ruschell advised that BR 143 has been pre filed by Representative Walker Thomas, which would remove the necessity for Audiologist to hold a Specialist in Hearing Instrument License. Mr. Winstead advised he found an error in bill that corrects the Boards address in one section, but not another. Ms. Roof will pass this information along.
